



SOBER HOUSING (Recovery Housing) in DANE COUNTY

Sober house - affordable, alcohol and drug free environment that provides a positive place for peer-group recovery; for addicts/alcoholics.

Halfway house - residential center for drug users, sex offenders, the mentally ill, or convicted felons upon release from a primary institution such as a prison, hospital or rehabilitation facility.
