

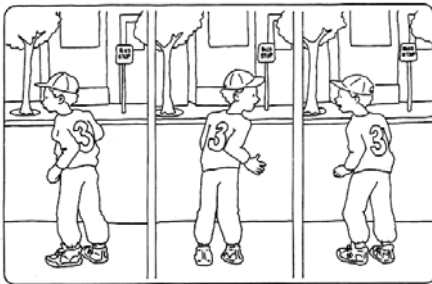
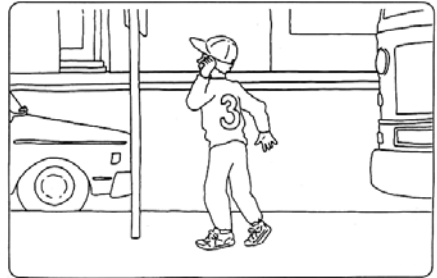
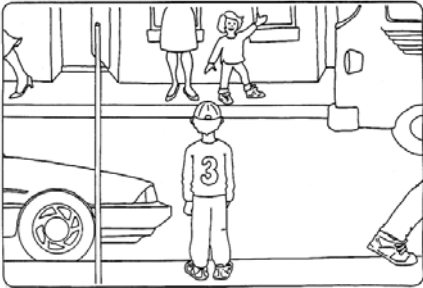

Pedestrian Safety

- Children under the age of six should not cross the street (even a quiet one) by themselves.
- Walk safely yourself; your children will imitate you.
- Teach children over the age of six the steps in crossing the street:
 - Stop at the edge of the street; never dart into the street.
 - Look left, right and left again before crossing.
 - Go to the edge of parked cars to search for traffic.
 - Keep looking for cars when crossing.
 - Cross the street quickly, but do not run.
